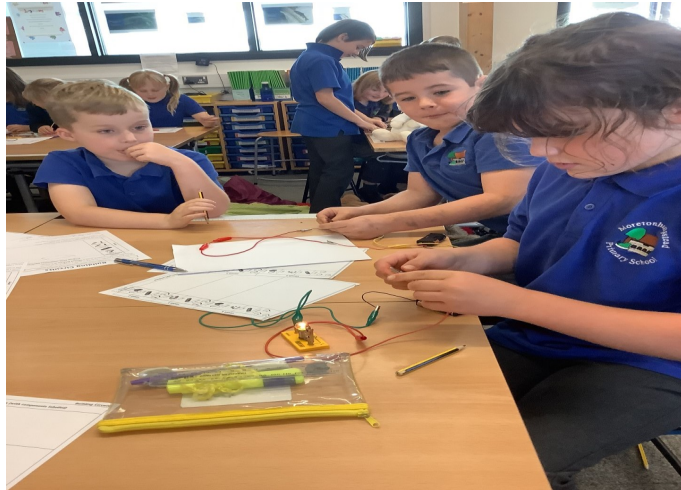
## Easdon

In Mardon, we have been building circuits and learning about what makes a complete circuit. We have also been learning about conductors and insulators.

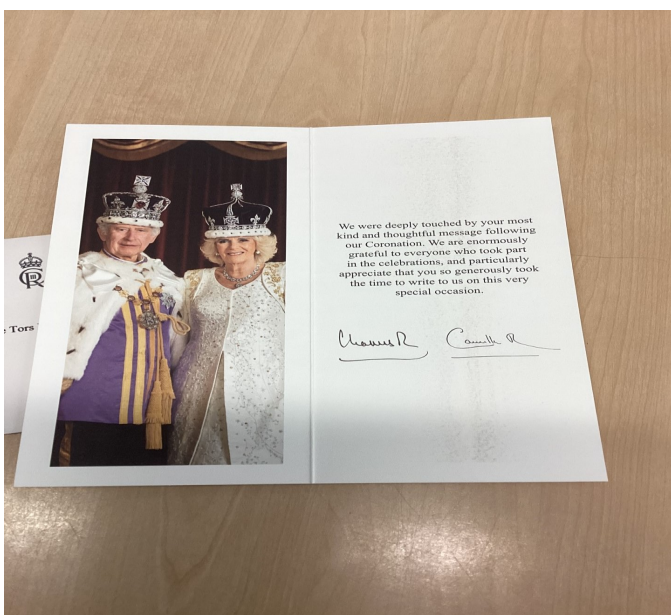


## Beckaford
