When we reopen and in order to keep everyone safe and meet Government Guidance, we need to insist on the following:

Attendance at school will be compulsory for all children, including those who have been shielding. The school will call all parents by 9.30am if a child is not in school and we have not been contacted to ensure that they are safe.

Children must not attend if they, or someone they live with, are displaying symptoms of coronavirus. Uniform is to be worn (it does not need to be washed more than normally).

## Parents:

It is essential that all children are in their classroom, settled and ready to begin by the 'Teaching Session Begins' time.

It is an expectation that parents will follow social distancing guidance during drop —off and pick-ups, using the markings provided to support this.

It is important that parents are punctual and keep to the staggered times when dropping off and picking up. Persistent lateness will not be acceptable.

Only one parent to escort child(ren) to school please. Walk to school if possible.

Parents are not, unfortunately, permitted into the school building.

Parents to leave site immediately after drop off/ pick up.

Parents should email or telephone us if they wish to communicate with their child's teacher.

If providing a packed lunch, please ensure your child can open packaging etc independently.

Parents should not send in unnecessary equipment such as toys.

I hope you understand the need to have these 'regulations'- you have all been brilliant this term and thank you for your support during this difficult time and for your continued support in September.
